



2023 Men's League Information

League Timing:

Every Wednesday Night @ 5:15 pm from April 5th – May 3rd. We will then start at 5:30 until the end of season September 27th. If adjustments need to be made they will be communicated. There will be no men's league on June 7th due to the proximity of the SGB Member/Guest. There will be a total of 24 weeks for the entire season. Cost: \$400 Per Team, and can be either charged to an individual account or billed directly to your business. Fees will cover flag prizes, winnings, and end of the year food!

Teams:

Players must have a GHIN handicap established to play in the Men's League. Teams will consist of four players. The amount of teams will determine the amount of bye weeks. Our ultimate goal is to keep the bye weeks to a minimum. If there is an issue with points at the end of the year, an average will be taken of each week's points and that will be given to the team with fewer playing weeks to reach a total. It is the team's responsibility to notify the golf shop if this situation is occurring.

Payouts:

Will be in pro shop credit! Each team will win a dollar for each point accrued, and individuals will make money based off flag prizes.

Team Lists:

Please provide a weekly player list at least forty-eight (48) hours before the round begins. This will help with accuracy of scoring and how quickly results can be returned and posted to the website.

Scorecards:

Scorecards will be available one hour before the round starts. PLEASE DROP YOUR SCORECARDS IN THE GOLF SHOP RIGHT AWAY following your Round of Golf!!!

If any card is not turned in by the end of the night, those teams will not earn any points. The pro shop will check to make sure the scoring is correct and keeping a running total of the points throughout the year!

All league scores will be posted by the golf shop staff that night! We ask that you don't post the league round due to having a duplicate score. Any round played prior, for example, practice round is on you to post.

Net Par:

Per the USGA Handicapping Rules

Adjustment of Hole Scores

Q. I did not play a hole. What score do I post?

A. When a hole is not played, for example, due to darkness or construction, the score recorded for handicap purposes is net par, equal to par plus any handicap strokes you are entitled to receive based on your Course Handicap™.

For example: A Player with a Course Handicap of 21 receives 1 handicap stroke on all 18 holes and 2 handicap strokes on holes with a stroke index of 1 through 3 on the scorecard.

On a par-3 hole with a stroke index of 17, the player's net par score is 4 (3 + 1). (*Rule 3.2, Rules of Handicapping*)

Subs:

Subs must be full golf members of BCC and must have an established GHIN handicap prior to their first night of subbing. If you do not have an active or established GHIN, you will play as a zero (0) handicap until you have one established. It is the responsibility of the team to fill their line-up, not the golf shop. We will have a sub list for those available weekly but we encourage you to find your own before calling us. If by chance that no subs are available, you will still be able to compete against your opponent that night based on the format.

Format:

Match play with four individual matches per team per night (same as 2022 scoring) will be used for all league scoring, along with a one-net best ball portion per pairing. GHIN Handicap will be used, and the total number of matches won will determine how your team will accumulate points. A total of four team points will be up for grabs each night. (One point for a match win, ½ point for halving the MATCH, and zero points for losing the match.)

Playoff Format:

In the playoffs only, we will have a tie-breaker of most holes won per team in individual matches. If a tie still occurs, we will go to most holes won by an individual.

No Opponent:

If your opponent no-shows, your team will win the match.

SKINS:

A \$5 per player per week skins game will be available. The format of skins is the Best Net Score for each hole will win a skin, payouts are pro-rated which means each skin will be paid out a percentage of the total pot in the skins game. Example: There are 2 skins won on hole(s) 3 & 9, the total pot for skins is \$60. That means each skin was worth \$30 and will be paid back in cash. Skins will be announced along with League Results and will be posted. The Pro-Shop will hold the payouts until claimed by the winner. Subs and players are both allowed to get into the skins game and win a prize.
